## LOCAL NOTICE to MARINERS 7 of 2014.

### Sluicing of the Dock Channel

**Mariners are hereby advised** that sluicing of the Dock Channel will take place over the LW period after the following HW tide times:

<b>Saturday</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>March</b>	<b>10.58hrs</b>	<b>GMT</b>
<b>Sunday</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup></b>	<b>March</b>	<b>11.42hrs</b>	<b>GMT</b>
<b>Monday</b>	<b>3<sup>rd</sup></b>	<b>March</b>	<b>12.25hrs</b>	<b>GMT</b>

**Vessels are not permitted** to tie up or remain on the waiting pontoon over the low water periods of sluicing

Trawler skippers are requested to ensure that there is sufficient scope in their moorings to allow for the fall in the dock level.

The lock gates may close slightly earlier than usual after HW on these tides.

Vessels requiring a lock-in within 1.5 hours following HW should make their request to the Lockhead staff **no later** than the HW time.
